## 10. Directors Report

- Unemployment rate for Georgia is 3.4% while the national average is 3.9%
- There is grant funding that needs to be spent by June 30
- There will be an IIJA Summit on April 19. The Build Georgia: A Workforce Partnership
  meeting will be by invitation only and will focus on preparing Georgia's workforce for
  future projects which will be implemented with the large funding from the Federal
  government.
- The ARWDB consultant Rocket Camp is currently running an ad campaign on Instagram and Facebook with good results. Over 650,000 impressions and 15,000 clicks were made which bring the average cost to \$.77 per click. Very good results. The campaign will run through March 31.
- There are currently two bills in the Georgia Congress that would allow for virtual participation at ARWDB Committee meetings.
