2. **FIRST READ - Chattahoochee RiverLands Study** *Byron Rushing, ARC*

The Chattahoochee RiverLands study has completed major planning milestones. A briefing on the plan will be provided and major planned initiatives highlighted. This is a first read for a resolution and the final reviews and action on the plan is scheduled for July.
