 - ARPA Grant Received \$13.5M over 2 years
 - New pilot: Funding for individuals referred by Adult Protective Services (APS)
- Notice of Funding Availability Available Fall 2023
 - Occurs every 2 years
- o Healthcare Access Summit Held on July 10th



- Closure of two Wellstar Hospitals within metro Atlanta
- Proposed Solutions
 - Reform the Certificate of Need (CON) process
 - Expand Medicaid Expanding Medicaid may reach 500,000 Georgians vs 50,00 through the new Pathways program.
 - Inverting the Burden
 - Provide holistic care (including supporting social needs) to improve health outcomes
 - Shifting the burden of addressing racism and other inequities to institutions rather than solely on individuals.
- o CO-AGE Priorities
 - Budget Home and Community Based Services goes to Area Agencies on Aging to address waiting lists.
 - Legislation
 - Multi-disciplinary teams for elder abuse
 - Medical assistance in dying (MAID)

 - Major Initiatives and Programs (MIPs Departmental Processes)
 - o Key Performance Indicators (KPI Measures)






Top 3 Issues Across Region
