

- Encourage a collaborative and inclusive ecosystem of arts, culture, and creative placemaking in metro Atlanta

ALMA Workshop 2021

- Select a class of 32 participants reflective of the region's racial/ethnic diversity
- Cross-sector collaboration 1/3rd artists, 1/3rd planners, and 1/3rd local officials
- 6 teams working on 3 different projects that focused on the community engagement process, especially for groups that we have excluded in the past
- Embed arts and culture in ARC community planning projects


