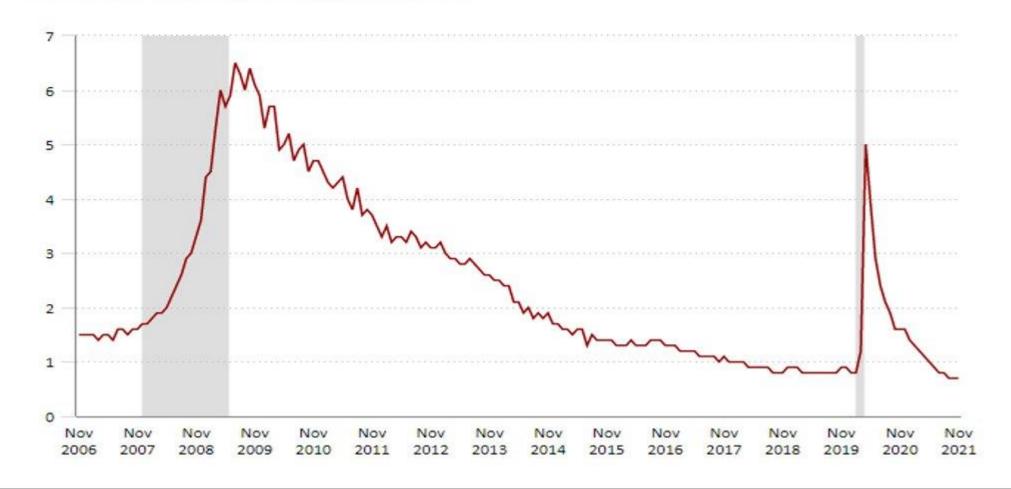

#### Number of unemployed persons per job opening, seasonally adjusted

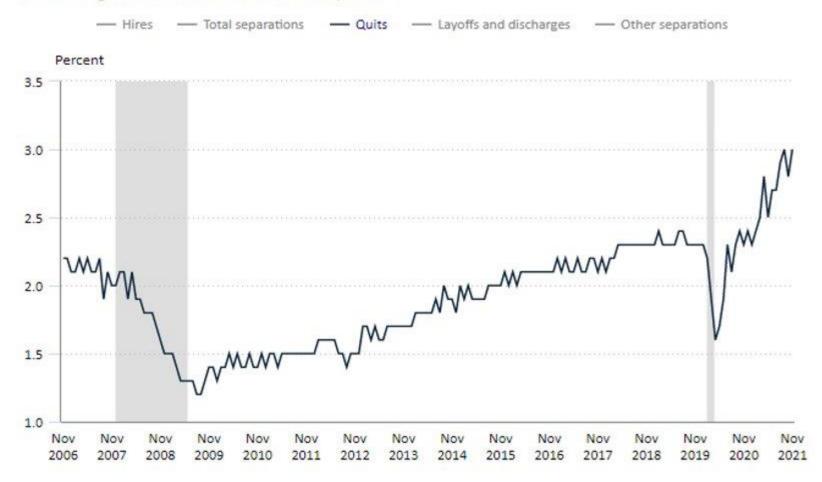

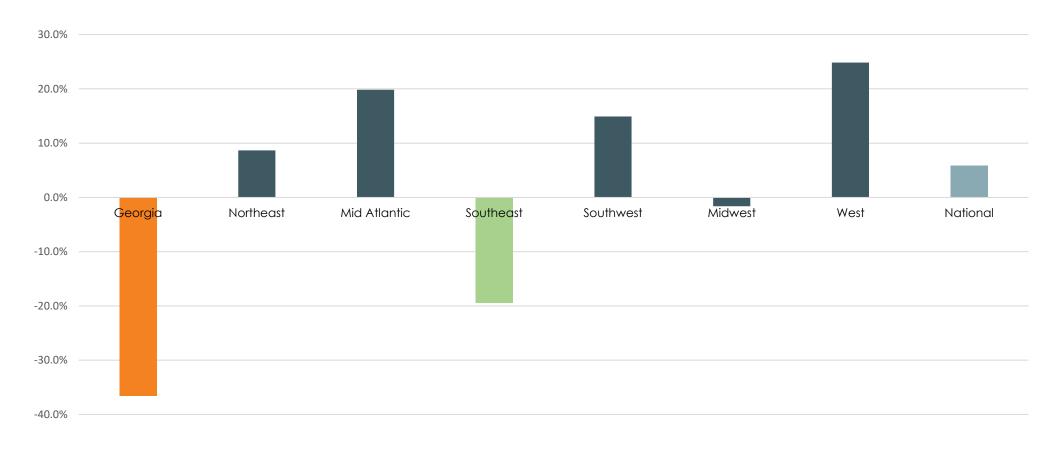

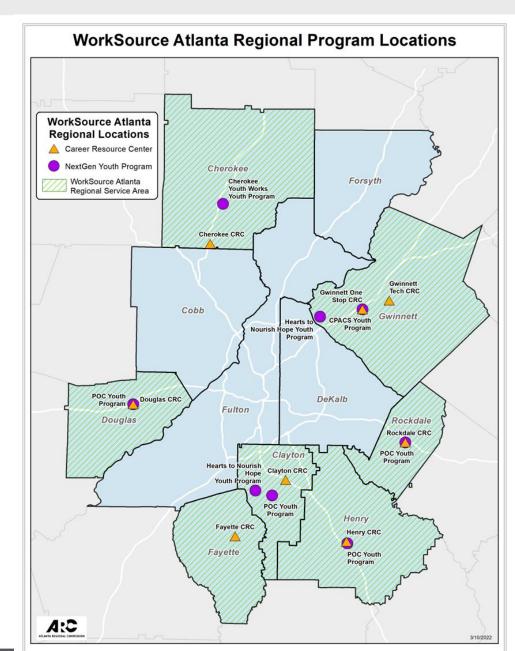

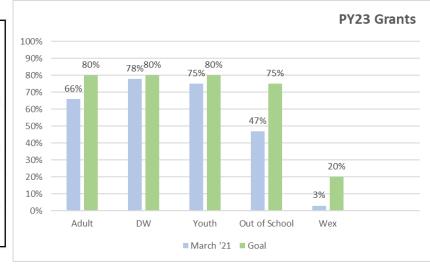
