The Community Development **Assistance Program (CDAP) provides** planning assistance to local governments, CIDs, & non-profits across the 10-county metropolitan region to undertake local planning activities that advance the goals of the Atlanta Region's Plan.

- Advance socially equitable planning processes & outcomes
- Promote community resiliency to safeguard against future shocks & stressors
- Foster comprehensive, inclusive, & meaningful community engagement
