











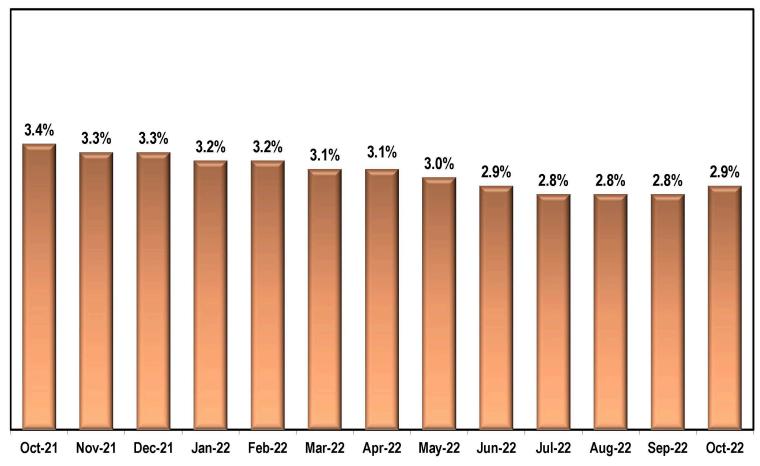

(Seasonally Adjusted)



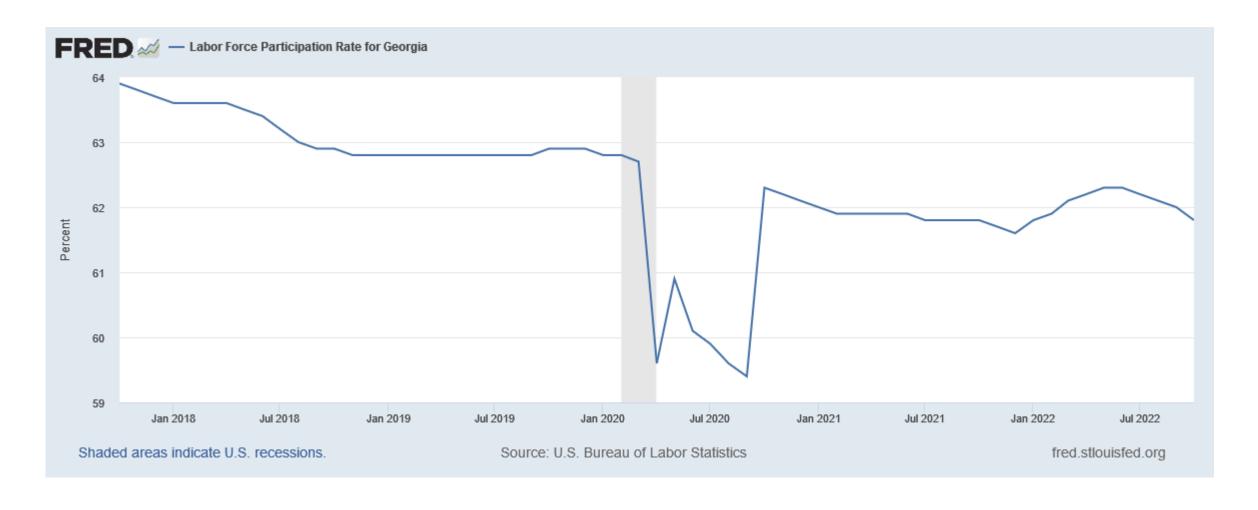

In October 2022, Georgia's unemployment rate (seasonally adjusted) increased to **2.9 percent** over the month.

Although Georgia's unemployment rate remains well below the **3.7 national** average, this is the first unemployment rate increase since April 2020.

Over the year, Georgia's unemployment rate is down from 3.4 percent in October 2021.

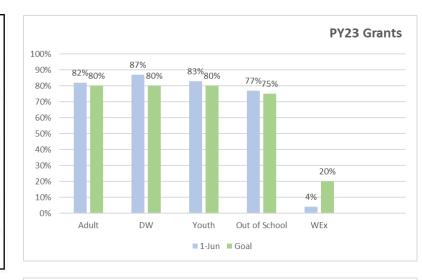

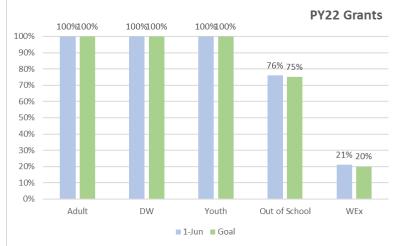
