New Funding Opportunities

Active Transportation Infrastructure Investment Program (ATIIP)

- \$45.6 million available nationally
- For construction projects, awards will range from \$7.5 million to \$15.0 million (e.g., 3 to 5 projects)
- Applications due June 17

Innovative Finance and Asset Concession Grant Program

- \$57.7 million available nationally
- Provides support to evaluate public-private partnerships and explore innovative finance and project delivery options for TIFIA eligible projects
- Application due May 10

New Funding Opportunities

Low Carbon Transportation Materials Program

- **\$1.2 billion available to state DOTs nationally under Inflation Reduction Act**
- **Incentivizes use of “low-embodied carbon materials and products” in transportation projects**
- **Each responsive state is guaranteed a minimum of \$22 million**
- **Another \$800 million will be available to cities, counties and MPOs later in 2024**
- **Applications due June 10**

Other Current Funding Opportunities

Safe Streets and Roads for All

- \$1.3 billion available nationally
- Three rolling deadlines for planning and demonstration grants (April 4, May 16, and August 29)
- Deadline for implementation grants is May 16

Congestion Relief Program

- \$150 million available nationally
- Limited to urbanized areas with a population greater than one million people
- Emphasis on innovative, integrated and multimodal solutions (e.g., tolling, ITS, transit services)
- State DOTs, MPOs, cities and municipalities are eligible (but not counties – legislatively defined)
- Applications due April 22

Other Current Funding Opportunities

EPA Clean Ports Program

- \$3.0 billion available nationally under IRA (not IIJA)
- Zero emission equipment and infrastructure at port facilities (includes major intermodal yards, aka “dry ports”)
- Several CSX and Norfolk Southern facilities are eligible
- Government jurisdictions where a facility is located is located are eligible to apply; private sector owner of facility may apply in partnership with the relevant government
- Applications due May 28

Bus and Bus Facilities / Low or No Emission Bus

- \$1.5 billion available under both programs combined
- Applications due April 25

Pending Opportunities (Likely Within 3 Months)

Railroad Crossing Elimination Program (RCEP)

Charging and Fueling Infrastructure Program (CFI)

- **ARC is in the process of scheduling a roundtable discussion with local government sustainability officers on options for a possible regional application**
- **ARC may be able to serve as a pass-through agency with subgrant agreements with local government partners (no decision has been made)**
- **More information and partnership opportunities will be provided at a future meeting**

Pending Award Announcements

Promoting Resilient Operations for Transformative, Efficient, and Cost-saving Transportation Program (PROTECT)

- Estimated \$848M available nationally
- Applications were due August 18, 2023

Bridge Investment Program (Large Bridges)

- Unknown amount available
- Applications were due November 27, 2023
