LCI Overview



What Is the Livable Centers Initiative (LCI) Program?



- Reimbursable grant program (80/20 split)
- Applicant must be a CID or local government
- Approximately \$2 million in funding available annually
- Studies focus on "Main Streets" and Downtowns or Transit Areas
- Tactical or Catalytic Studies



How Do LCI's Goals Address ARC's Strategic Framework?

- Healthy, safe, livable communities
 - Co-location of diverse housing, employment, recreational, and cultural amenities at major transit, local, and regional centers for people of all ages, abilities, and income levels
 - Enhance access to a range of travel modes and increase connectivity.
- Diverse stakeholder engagement
 - Foster public-private partnerships and sustained community support through an inclusive outreach process.
