SUBJECT:	Update – One Stop Certification Criteria

## **Requested Action**

To adopt the One-Stop Certification criteria provided by the State Workforce Development Board (SWBD).

### Reason

In accordance with 20 CFR §678.800, the State Workforce Development Board (SWDB) developed the minimum criteria for the certification of the comprehensive and affiliate one-stops throughout Georgia. One-Stop certification criteria must be reviewed every two years, and recertification must be completed at least once every three years. The following criteria may be used for certification of one-stops during PY22 (July 1, 2022-June 30, 2023) and PY23 (July 1, 2023 – June 30, 2024). LWDBs must take formal action to adopt the criteria as their official certification process by June 30, 2022.

# Timeframe

The criteria will be valid through June 30, 2024.

# Impact

There is no financial impact.

### Recommendation

Staff recommend adoption of the State provided One Stop Certification guidelines approved by the SWDB.
