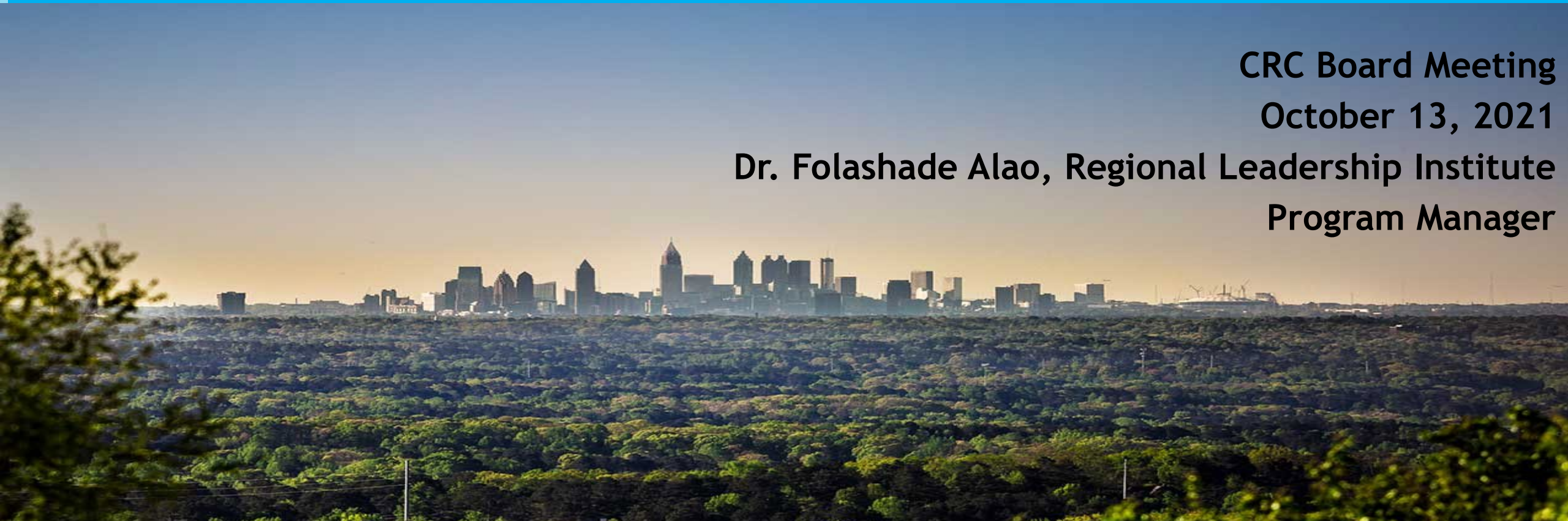

Origins of RLI- 1991



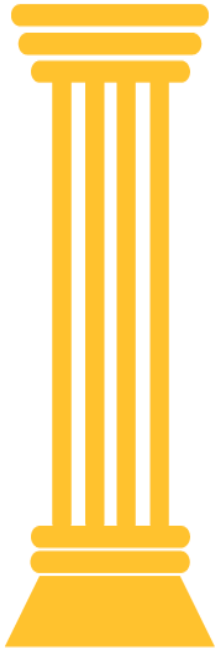
