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In Summary...

Metro Atlanta's overall cost-of-living is slightly **above** the national average. New York City, not surprisingly, has the highest cost of living.

Someone in metro Atlanta with a \$50,000 salary moving to New York would need to make \$121,200 to have equivalent spending power. A move to San Francisco, requires \$96,100, and a move to Dallas requires \$53,300.

Atlanta's cost of living related to housing is slightly higher than some of its peer metros, but this is offset by its comparatively cheaper utility costs.


When considering individual items, groceries in metro Atlanta are 5 percent more expensive than in the average metro area, but utilities are 15.4 percent less expensive.







Cost of Living for 25 Most Populous Metros











Atlanta Consumer Price Over Time

(2000 = 100)













Mapping Cost of Living





Income needed for equivalent of \$50,000 in Atlanta










Comparing highest vs. lowest COLI in the 25 most populous metros










Cost of Living Comparison: Peer Metros










Relationship Between Income and Cost of Living










Average Home Price: 25 Largest Metros




