ISSUE SUMMARY: 2020 ARC Audit Annual Report Review

IMPORTANCE:

ARC has completed its annual audit of its accounts. This audit was conducted in accordance with the standards applicable to financial audits contained in *Government Auditing Standards*, and issued by the Comptroller General of the United States. ARC is required to submit the auditor's report to the governing body of each member within the region and to the Department of Community Affairs. The audit report must be completed and forwarded to the state auditor within 180 days after the close of the fiscal year, and within 30 days of the audit report due date, any written comments on the findings and recommendations must be submitted, including a corrective action plan as necessary. However, this year due to unforeseen delays in processing and administration by ARC, ARC was granted an extension (without penalty) from the appropriate Federal and State authorities. This timing was previously shared with the Subcommittee with a submission set for today

The auditors have issued an unmodified opinions for Annual Comprehensive Financial Report (ACFR) and Pension Trust for 2020.

ACTION REQUIRED:

Acceptance of the audit report and forwarding it to the State and Federal Audit Clearinghouse.



A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING THE ATLANTA REGION COMMISSION'S 2020 AUDIT ANNUAL REPORT REVIEW

WHEREAS, the Atlanta Regional Commission is a Regional Commission created pursuant to O.C.G.A. § 50-8-30, et seq.; and

WHEREAS, O.C.G.A. § 50-8-38 requires such a commission to keep books of account reflecting all funds received, expended, and administered by the regional commission which shall be independently audited at least once in each fiscal year during which a regional commission functions, and such audit shall be conducted in accordance with generally accepted government auditing standards.; and

WHEREAS, O.C.G.A. § 50-8-38 further requires that the auditor's report shall be presented to the governing body of each member within the region and to the department; and

WHEREAS, the Atlanta Regional Commission is also a Metropolitan Area Planning and Development Commission created pursuant to O.C.G.A. § 50-8-80, et seq.; and

WHEREAS, O.C.G.A. § 50-8-101 also requires such a commission to keep books of account which shall be independently audited at least once in each full calendar year during which a commission functions; and

WHEREAS, O.C.G.A. § 50-8-101 also further requires that the auditor's report shall be presented to the governing body of each political subdivision within the area and to the General Assembly; and

WHEREAS, the audit report for calendar year 2020 has been completed and submitted to the ARC Governance Committee.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Atlanta Regional Commission accepts the 2020 Annual Comprehensive Financial Report as submitted and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Atlanta Regional Commission directs staff to submit the Report to all parties required under state law and federal law.
