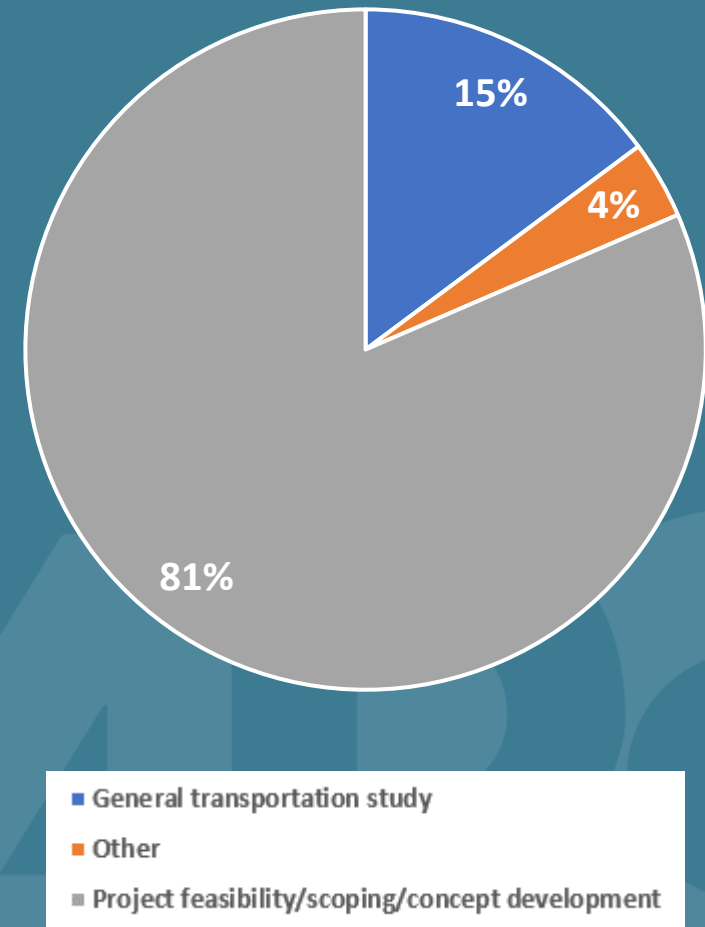


# Summary of Application Submittals



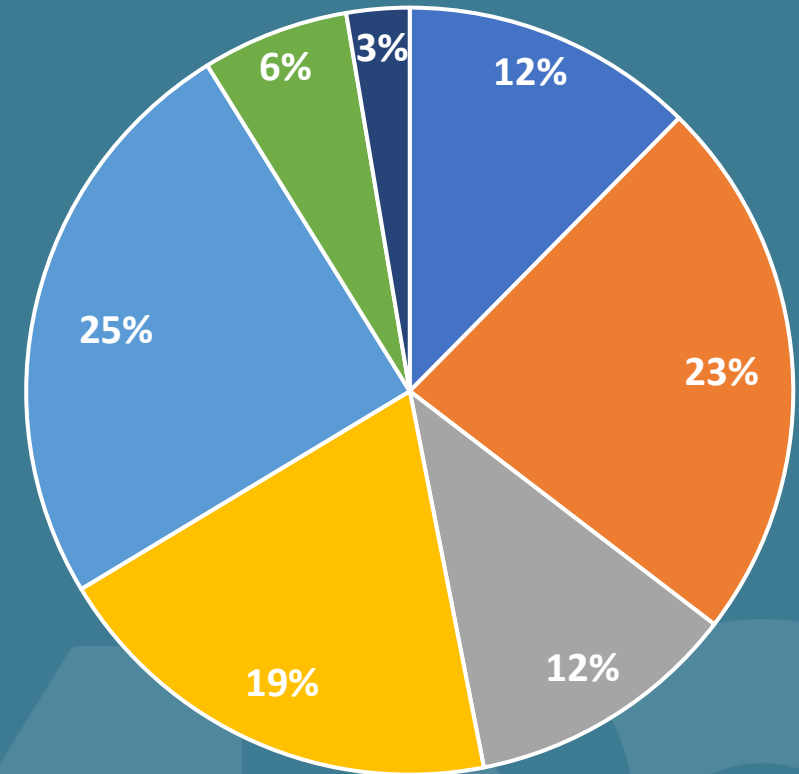
# Study Applications Received

- Potential sponsors submitted 27 applications
- Study categories:
  - General transportation study (4)
  - Project feasibility/scoping/concept development (22)
  - Other (1)
- Total funding requested (including non-federal match) \$14,960,000



# Infrastructure Applications Received

- Potential sponsors submitted 114 applications
- Infrastructure categories:
  - Bike/Ped (14)
  - Multiuse Trails (26)
  - Roadway - Asset Management (13)
  - Roadway - Capacity Expansion (22)
  - Roadway - Operations & Management (28)
  - Transit - Asset Management (7)
  - Transit - Capacity Expansion (3)
- Total funding requested (including non-federal match) \$999,161,830

# Schedule


- Application Period - October 1, 2021 to December 2, 2021
- KDP1 Review - December 2021 to January 2022
- KDP2 Technical Evaluation - Begins February 2022
- Initial Recommendations - Expected Late Spring 2022
- Final Recommendations - Expected Summer 2022
- Recommended projects and phases will be programmed as part of TIP Amendment #5 (schedule TBD)

# Next Steps

- KDP 1 Review - Check for complete applications
  - Jurisdiction liaisons will be reaching out to project sponsor if data items or documents are incomplete
  - Data must be complete to move on to KDP 2
- Meeting with GDOT/ATL Authority/GRTA
  - To be held in late January
  - Review all application submittals
  - Checking for deliverability issues or concerns (budget, schedule, scope)
  - LAP-certification status will be reviewed before, during, and after meeting with GDOT
  - For transit projects, checking for consistency with ARTP
- KDP 2 - Technical Evaluation
  - CMAQ Emissions Calculator for eligible projects
  - Evaluation criteria as outlined in the Project Evaluation Framework (aka Cookbook)

The Atlanta Regional Commission will conduct a solicitation for TIP project funding proposals during the Fall of 2021. Federal funding from the Surface Transportation Block Grant Program (STBG), which includes the setaside for Transportation Alternatives, ARC's Livable Centers Initiative (LCI) program, and the Congestion Mitigation and Air Quality (CMAQ) program will be awarded to implement projects which support the goals and objectives of the Atlanta Region's Plan.

Sponsors may apply for federal funding to add new projects to the TIP, supplement funding for existing TIP projects, and submit proposals for studies and related initiatives which do not result in the construction of physical infrastructure.
