2022 TIP Solicitation Process Overview

- Project call for four regional federal fund programs:
 - Surface Transportation Block Grant (STBG) – Urban
 - Congestion Mitigation and Air Quality (CMAQ)
 - Transportation Alternatives Program (TAP)
 - Carbon Reduction Program (CRP)
- Application period – October 1, 2021 to December 2, 2021
- Over 140 applications total submitted (Studies & Infrastructure)

Applications

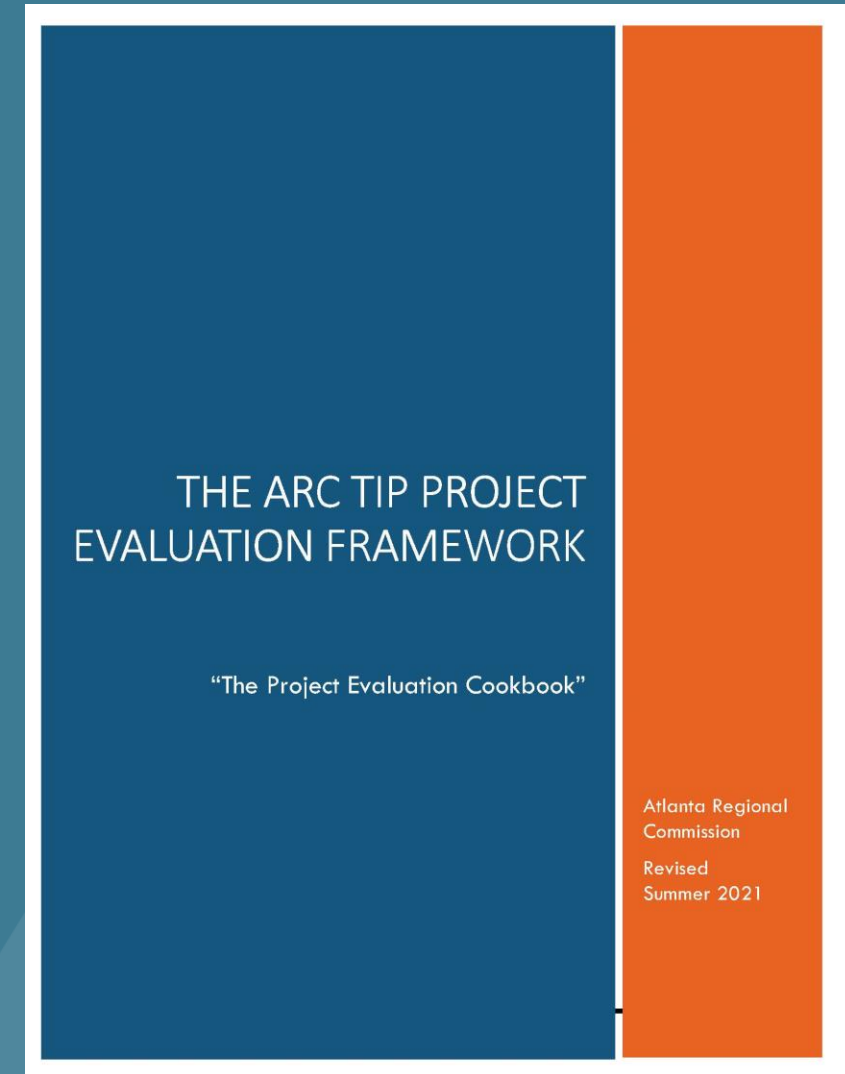
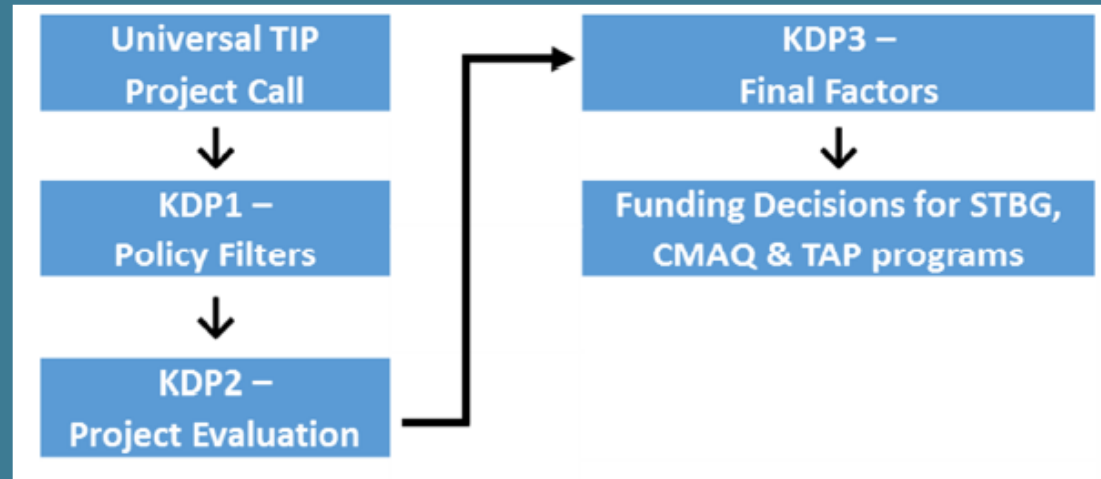
Studies

- 28 submitted and evaluated
- Total federal requested = \$15.97 million

Infrastructure

- 112 submitted and evaluated
- Total federal requested = \$742.69 million
 - PE federal requested = \$83.7 million
 - ROW federal requested = \$108 million
 - UTL federal requested = \$22.3 million
 - CST federal requested = \$528.7 million


Notes:

- STBG program annual budget averages \$102M per TIP year
 - \$20 Million ‘set aside’ for implementation of LCI transportation projects
- TAP program annual budget averages \$16M per TIP year
- CMAQ program annual budget \$29 Million per TIP year

The Atlanta Regional Commission will conduct a solicitation for TIP project funding proposals during the Fall of 2021. Federal funding from the Surface Transportation Block Grant Program (STBG), which includes the setaside for Transportation Alternatives, ARC's Livable Centers Initiative (LCI) program, and the Congestion Mitigation and Air Quality (CMAQ) program will be awarded to implement projects which support the goals and objectives of the Atlanta Region's Plan.

Sponsors may apply for federal funding to add new projects to the TIP, supplement funding for existing TIP projects, and submit proposals for studies and related initiatives which do not result in the construction of physical infrastructure.
