
2019 TIP Solicitation Process Overview

- Project call for three regional federal fund programs:
 - Surface Transportation Block Grant (STBG) Urban
 - Congestion Mitigation and Air Quality (CMAQ)
 - Transportation Alternatives Program (TAP)
- Application period closed in October 2019
- 180 applications total submitted (includes PlanIt requests)
- Technical evaluation and application review conducted late 2019 into early 2020
- First round programmed during TIP Amendment #1 (September 2020)
 - focused on programming more immediate fiscal year phases
- Second round focused on programming FY 2023 phases and beyond under TIP Amendment #2 (March 2021)






