What Triggers an Amendment to the Transportation Improvement Program (TIP)?

Advancement of a federal funded phase from Long Range to TIP period (or vice versa) or moving of phases in and out of the TIP period triggering travel demand model network year changes

Increasing the cost of existing project phases in excess of \$2 million or 20% more than current total phase cost

Adding a new federally-funded phase to a project, excluding the addition of lump sum program line items

Why is Amendment #7 Required?

Advancement of a federal funded phase from Long Range to TIP period (or vice versa)

Increasing the cost of existing project phases in excess of \$2 million or 20% more than current total phase cost

Adding a new federally-funded phase to a project, excluding the addition of lump sum program line items

• TIP financial and schedule changes to close out FY 2023

 GDOT Statewide Transportation Improvement Program (STIP) rebalancing

 Cost changes to Major Mobility Investment Program (MMIP)

 General cost estimate increases to other federal-aid projects beyond threshold for an administrative modification





Amendment 7 Financial Summary

- Amendment 7 proposes the following programming changes for 11 projects:
- Funding increase of \$120 million
 - Additional \$106 million in federal funding
 - Additional \$14 million in state funding
- Of the \$106 million in additional federal funds:
 - \$48 million from ARC programming authority fund sources
 - \$58 million from GDOT programming authority fund sources

Amendment 7 Project Details: ARC TIP FY 2023 Closeout



ARC TIP FY 2023 Closeout

- Changes proposed to program the majority of FY 2023 available balance for federal funds suballocated to ARC
 - All funds programmed to FY 2023 construction activities
 - Additional federal funding proposed to assist with sponsors on the following projects:
- 15th Street Extension City of Atlanta
 - ARCID: AT-306 / GDOTPI 0015019
 - Additional \$3.7M federal
- Lenox Road Trail and Safety Improvements City of Atlanta
 - ARCID: AT-316 / GDOTPI 0015999
 - Additional \$4.9M federal



ARC TIP FY 2023 Closeout

- Rock Quarry Road Widening Henry County
 - ARCID: HE-161A / GDOTPI 0015090
 - Additional \$13.3M federal
- SR 120 (Abbotts Bridge Road) Operations and Safety Improvements City of Johns Creek
 - ARCID: FN-287 / GDOTPI 0012788
 - Additional \$13.1M federal
- North Evermore Parkway Extension Gwinnett County
 - ARCID: GW-331 / GDOTPI 0007535
 - Additional \$12.9M federal



ARC TIP FY 2023 Closeout – SPLOST

- Leveraging federal funds through amendment 7 allows local governments to free SPLOST dollars to accelerate additional projects:
- Henry County
 - Countywide resurfacing program
 - McDonough Parkway extension
 - Jonesboro Road widening from I-75 to Mt. Carmel Road
 - Bill Gardner Road widening from SR 155 (North McDonough Road) to I-75
- City of Johns Creek
 - Old Alabama Road bridge replacements
 - Nesbit Ferry Road operational improvements
 - SR 141 (Medlock Bridge Road) at McGinnis Ferry Road intersection improvements
 - SR 141 (Medlock Bridge Road) at SR 120 intersection improvements



Amendment 7 Project Details: GDOT STIP Rebalancing



GDOT STIP Rebalancing


- Changes necessary on GDOT sponsored TIP projects in order to reflect recent STIP rebalancing efforts
 - Project cost inflation = primary driver
- SR 3 / US 41 (Northside Drive) at SR 8 (Donald Lee Hollowell Parkway) Intersection Improvements in Atlanta
 - ARCID: AT-003G / GDOTPI 0018298
 - Project construction and utility relocation activities moved from FY 2028 to long range (FY 2029 FY 2030)
 - No change in costs
- SR 92 (Campbellton-Fairburn Road) at SR 14 (South Fulton Parkway) Continuous Flow Interchange in City of South Fulton
 - ARCID: FS-350 / GDOTPI 0014081
 - Construction of way activities moved from FY 2028 to long range (FY 2029 FY 2030)
 - Right-of-way activities also moved from FY 2025 to FY 2028
 - No change in costs

MMIP Project Updates

- Top End I-285 Express Lanes from Atlanta Road to Henderson Road
 - ARCID: AR-ML-200 / GDOTPI 0001758
 - Project covers all preliminary engineering (PE) and right-of-way (ROW) acquisition activities on the northern portion of I-285
 - Additional \$44.9M federal



Amendment 7 Project Details: General Cost Estimate Increases



General Cost Estimate Increases

- Design and cost estimate updates which require an amendment:
- I-75 Collector-Distributor Lanes from I-285 to SR 331 (Forest Parkway) in Clayton County
 - ARCID: CL-AR-180 / GDOTPI 0012759
 - Additional \$2.4M federal
 - Adding new federal dollars to fund PE activities
- SR 42 Bridge Replacement at NS RR South of McDonough in Henry County
 - ARCID: HE-201 / GDOTPI 0013995
 - Additional \$8M federal
 - Cost increases in CST and UTL



General Cost Estimate Increases


- Design and cost estimate updates which require an amendment:
- I-85 New Interchange at McGinnis Ferry Road Gwinnett County
 - ARCID: GW-389A / GDOTPI 0013104
 - Additional \$2.9M federal
 - Adding additional GDOT-authority federal funds for CST



TIP Amendment #7 – Schedule

- 30-day Public Comment Period March 16 through April 14
 - Public Hearing Friday, April 7 (TCC meeting)
- Proposed Committee and Board Action
 - ARC TCC May 5
 - ARC TAQC May 10
 - ARC Board May 10
 - GRTA Board May 16
- Submit documentation to US DOT (FHWA & FTA) and US EPA for approval May 16
- Conformity Determination expected by early June 2023
