



What are we including?

- Existing facilities
 - ▶ **Trails**
 - Side paths, multi-use paths, park trails
 - 8 feet wide or greater
 - ▶ **Bike lanes**
 - Protected, buffered, and conventional
 - 4 feet wide or greater
