

GUIDANCE ON TIP PROJECT TYPES:

BICYCLE & PEDESTRIAN VS MULTI-USE TRAIL

When applying for TIP funding for an active mode project, you will need to categorize your project as **Bicycle & Pedestrian** or **Multi-Use Trail**. Please follow these guidelines to select the appropriate project type.

Choose **Bicycle & Pedestrian** if at least 50% of the project follows the alignment of a roadway. This includes sidewalks, protected bike lanes, sidepaths, and complete streets.

Choose **Multi-Use Trail** if at least 50% of the project runs on its own alignment outside of the road right-of-way. This includes rail-trails and greenways along creeks, power easements, or through parks.
